AIBL was founded on four basic principles: Education; Experience; Leadership; and Culture.

AIBL recognizes that through our collective efforts we can positively impact our native communities while using our culture as the foundation and guidance for our efforts. Our vision is to give American Indians a culturally relevant responsibility for contributing to society, while learning about themselves and their world – with the aspiration that these initiatives will bring about systemic change.

AIBL's success is exemplified through its thriving national network of grassroots student based organizations. This program has proven to be a culturally competent vehicle for leadership development and experiential learning for American Indians. AIBL National acts as the liaison between its student body and corporate enterprises such as IBM, Toyota, Blue Cross/Blue Shield, educational institutions such as the University of Montana, Harvard University and Gonzaga University, as well as a vast number of Tribal governments throughout the country. AIBL has cultivated over 2,500 alum; the majority of which have gone on to excel in business, economic development, education, and government. In addition to leadership roles, AIBL members surpass non AIBL members concerning higher education, whereas 85 percent of AIBL's founding members have Master degrees.

The true success of AIBL lies not only within our expansive reach, visible impacts on native communities, and extensive education, but is most vividly depicted within the individual anecdotes of our AIBL members.
