## Chapter of the Year Competition

## **Eligibility Requirements**

Your Chapter must have a current Application for the Establishment of an AIBL Chapter form or a Renewal of AIBL Chapter Status form on file at the National AIBL Office.

## **Competition Divisions**

The competition will be separated into three divisions: High School, Tribal College, and University.

#### **Awards**

\$1,000 cash prizes awarded for each category.

#### **Submission Instructions**

Your Presentation submission is due March 3rd, 2023, Midnight. The application is on our conference page website. This form will be considered your Registration for the competition.

### **Presentation Requirements**

Each Chapter will be given a total of **eight minutes** to provide a **LIVE** presentation on their Chapter. The presentation must be done in the format of a **PowerPoint**, **Prezi**, **or Keynote**. You may include a video in your presentation, but it is not required. Due to your limited time allotment, we advise keeping your introductions short. Also, due to limited time, your Chapter will **not** be allowed to use your own equipment. All presentations must be uploaded through this link:

#### **COY Submission**

Please make **3 printed copies** of your presentation slides to hand out to judges prior to presenting. Presentations must have an opening slide in the following format:

- Chapter of the Year Competition + Year
- Chapter Name
- Chapter Advisor
- Chapter Officers

## **Evaluation Criteria**

A panel of entrepreneurs, financial professionals, educators, and tribal leaders will judge each presentation. Judges will be allowed **10 minutes** for questions. A group of at least two student Chapter Members must be present for the Q&A session. Virtual presentation is not supported at this time. Winners will be announced at the conference awards banquet. Chapters will be judged on the following criteria. (Rating system: 5 = excellent, 4 = very good, 3 = good, 2 = fair, 1 = poor).

- Introduction of Chapter
- Past and present activities
- Leadership of activities
- Integration of American Indigenous Culture
- Community service projects
- Fundraising efforts
- Presentation skills
